



Old Hemlock English Setter

Create a Paper Bag Puppet

What you'll need:

- Brown or white paper lunch bag
- Old Hemlock Setter- Template
- Glue
- Scissors
- Optional: Markers, Crayons, Colored Pencils...

How to make your Paper Bag Puppet Dog Craft:

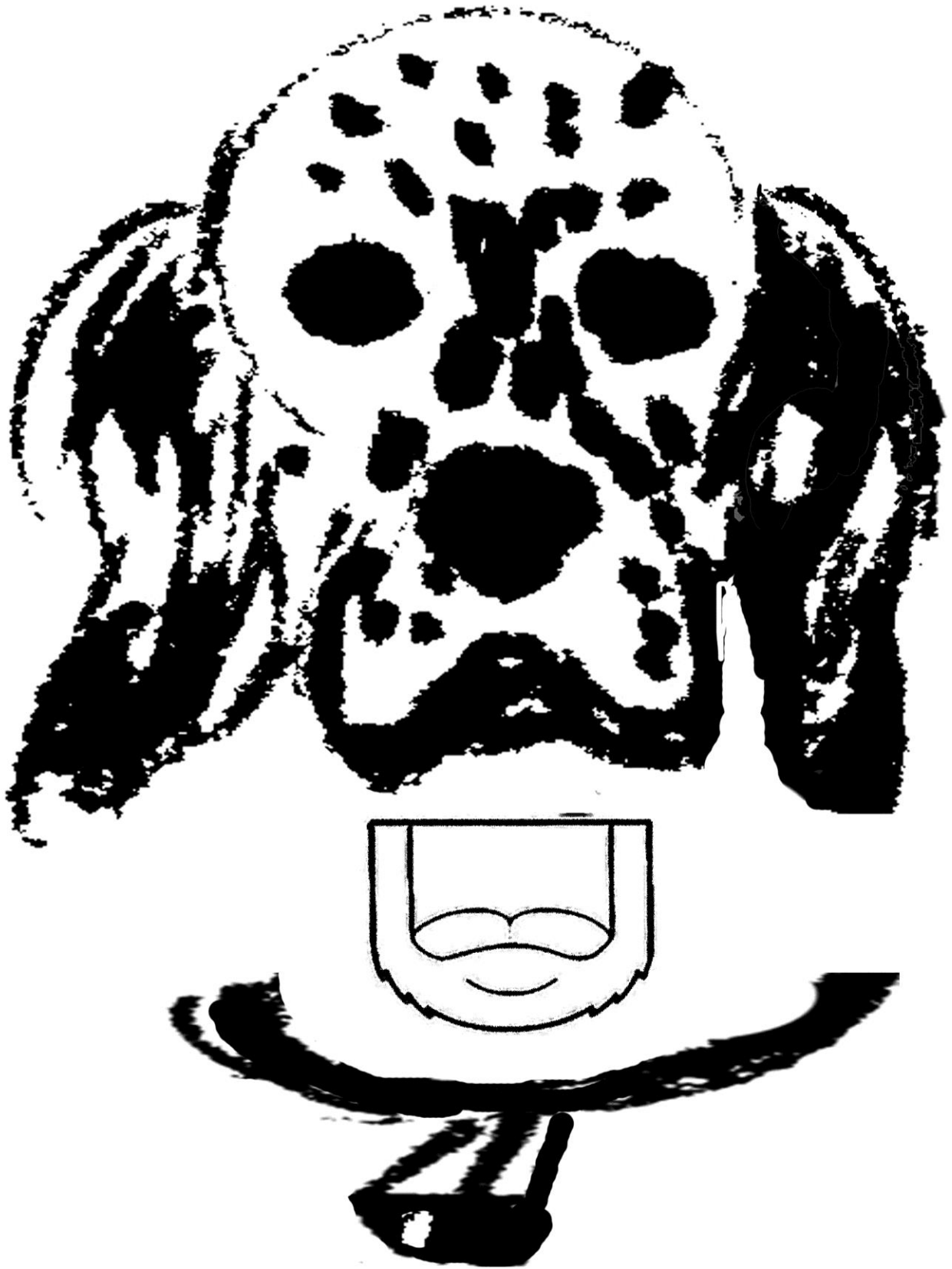
- Print the dog template and cut out the pieces. (Note: heavy paper like Vellum works best)
- Place your still-folded lunch bag on the table. You want to have the bottom of the bag facing up towards you.
- Glue your collar and bell onto the bag.
- Glue the Head onto the bottom flap of the bag.
- Glue on the open mouth under the flap.

Options:

- Use the template without spots to create your own pattern to make an orange or blue belton, or tri-color setter.
- Make and glue a name tag onto the collar.
- Create a set of paws. Glue the set of paws above the word feet midway down the bag and the lower set of paws at the bottom of the bag (near the opening). Or create your own feet and tail.
- Create a tail with feather and glue to back of back.

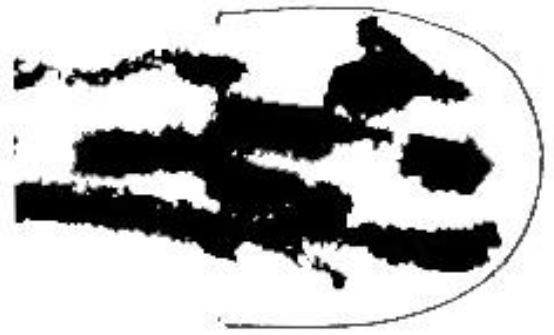

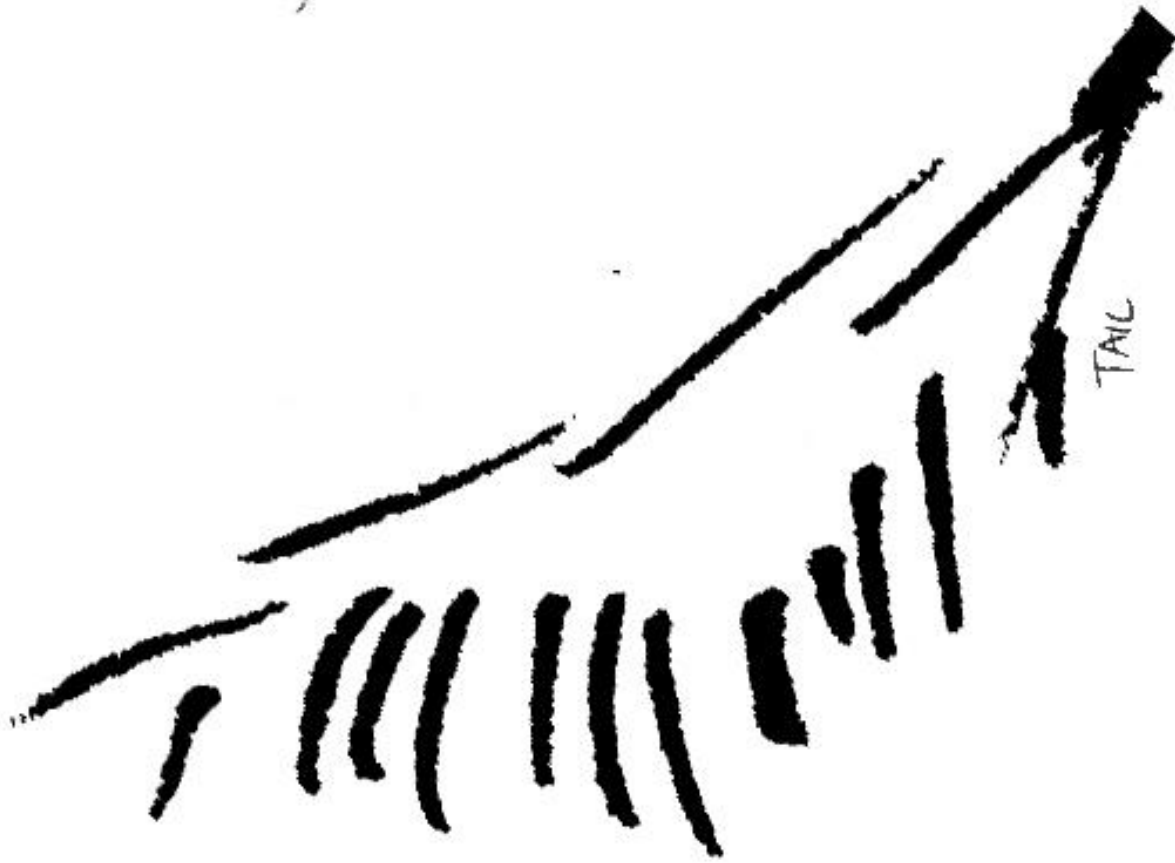
